The wood pile is for clean lumber, trees, and gardening materials **only**. We will **NOT** be accepting asphalt shingles, tires, paint cans or any other object not accepted in the Loraas grey bins. All you have to do is go to any Sarcan location that has a Drop & Go and type in their key code: "OELC" at the kiosk and the refund will be e-transferred to their account to be used towards the backyard.

Decks not attached to the house still require a permit along with utility sheds larger than 100SQ feet. If you are unsure about your project, please contact the village office.

Recycling:

On March 6th Gary & Joan Schatz and Annette Gaetz took a tour of the Crown Shred & Recycling Inc. This is the business that takes our recycling from our community. They moved into their new building Jan/2024 and is the most advanced facility in Canada.

Just Some Facts:

A bale of paper weights 2400-2500 lbs

A bale of tin weighs 3500-4000 lbs

Equip is capable of processing 120 tonnes a day or 2500 tonnes a month

8 miles of conveyor belts within the building

The conveyor belts are set up to sort out tin, plastic, cardboard etc but still have approx.

18-22 employees sorting and pulling out pieces that are not acceptable.

For example, pill bottles don't get recycled into the bales, but they pull all the bottles off the conveyor belts and shred them.

About 25% of the recycling, they receive is garbage (non recyclable items)

The bales get sent out daily and globally (China, Europe, India are just a few examples.)

Crown Shred & Recycling want to further educate the public on what is recyclable and what is not. This will hopefully encourage everyone to recycle and keep only garbage going to the landfill.

If you are unsure of what is and is not recyclable there is a list available at the village office.

Every 3 months our village gets a rebate of approx. \$1600 thru our recycling program. It is based on our tonnage, so the more we recycle, the more we will receive back.

Recycling will not only benefit our community but more importantly, our environment. Please recycle.
